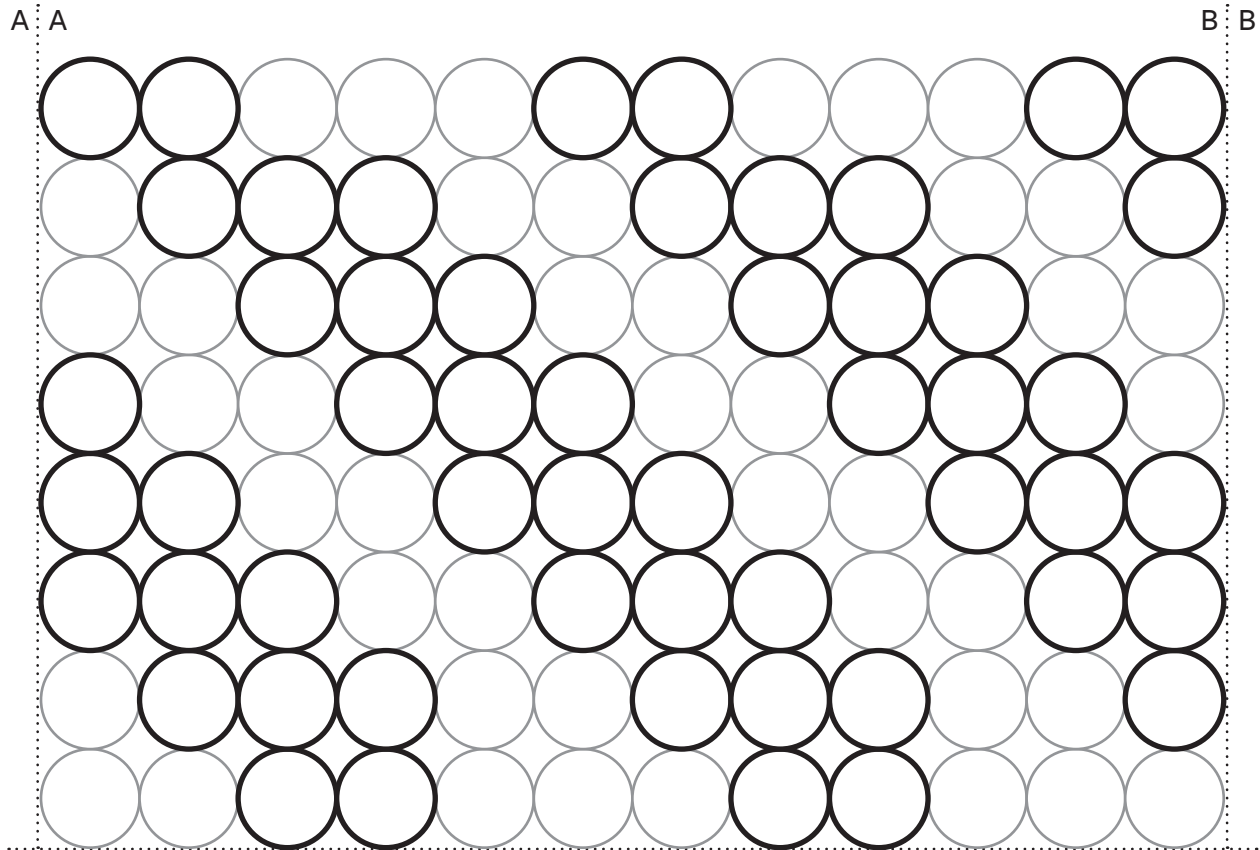
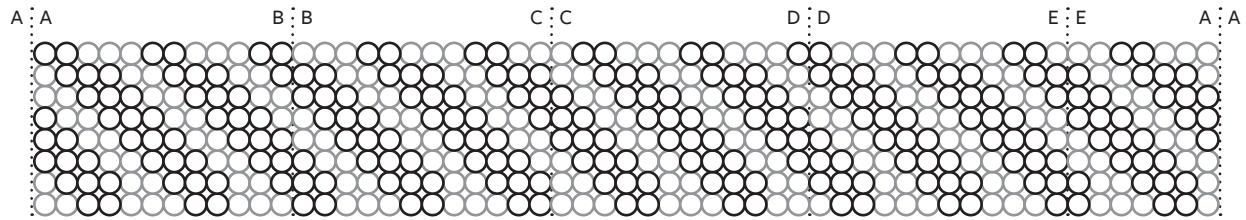

Design: Diagonal Stripes

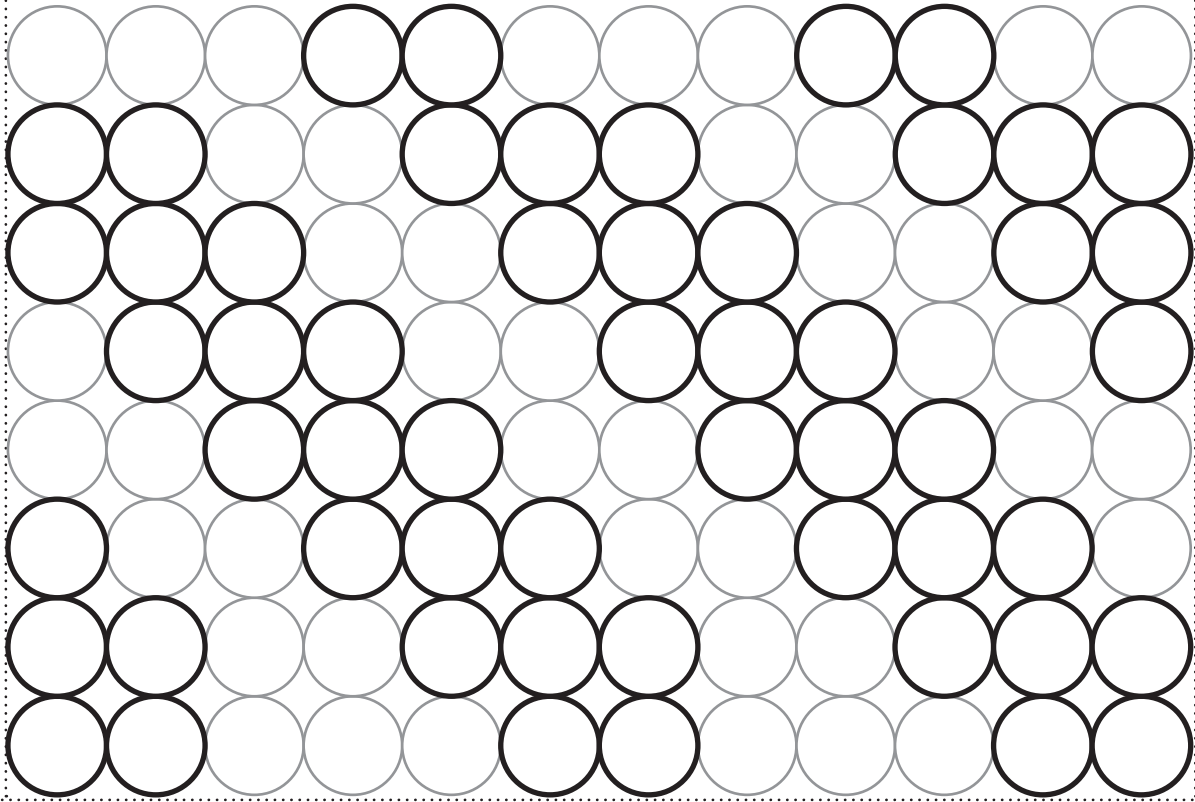
Specifications: This template is for a 9" round cake that is 4" tall (two 2" layers stacked) and candies that are approximately 1/2" in diameter (plain M&M's® Candies, for example).

- Instructions:**
- 1) Print this template on 8.5" x 11" paper in portrait setting at 100% (no scaling).
 - 2) Cut along the vertical and horizontal dotted lines and paste the pieces back together, matching up the letters and the dotted lines.
 - 3) Plan the colors of your design by filling in the circles with colored pencils or by placing the candies on the template before applying them to the cake.



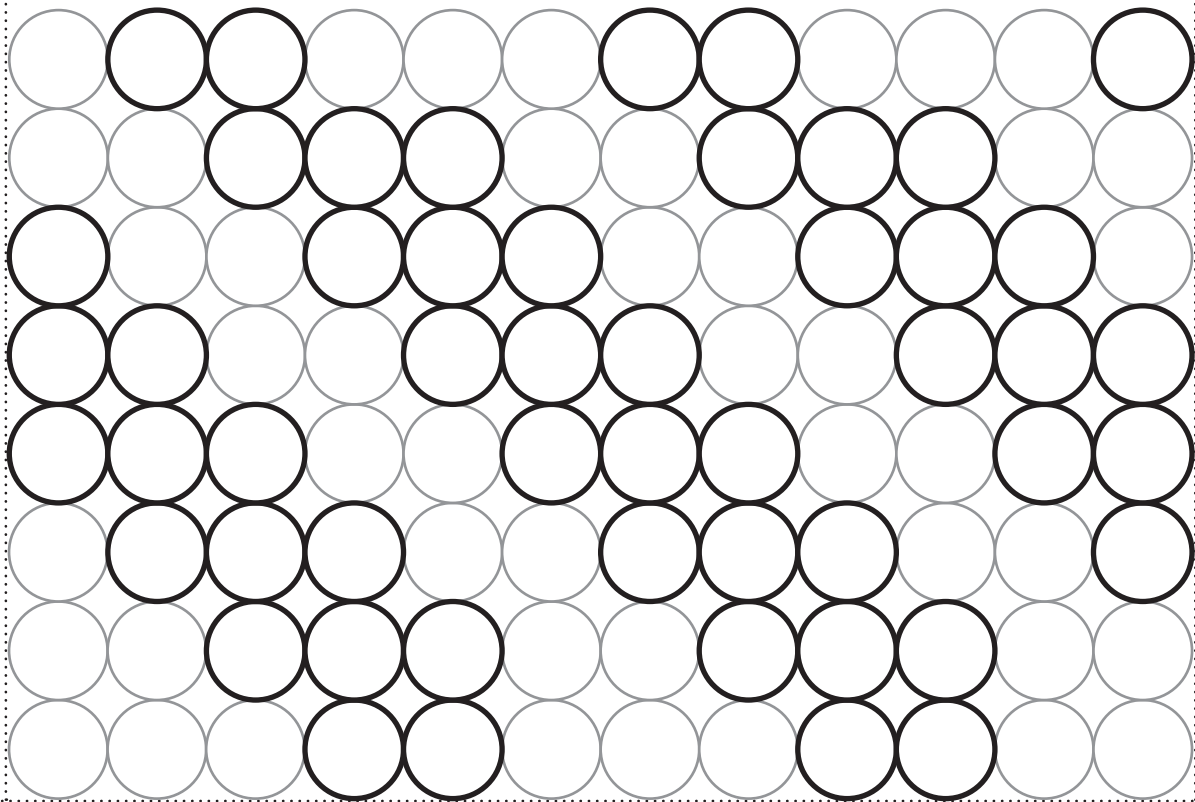

Design: Create Your Own

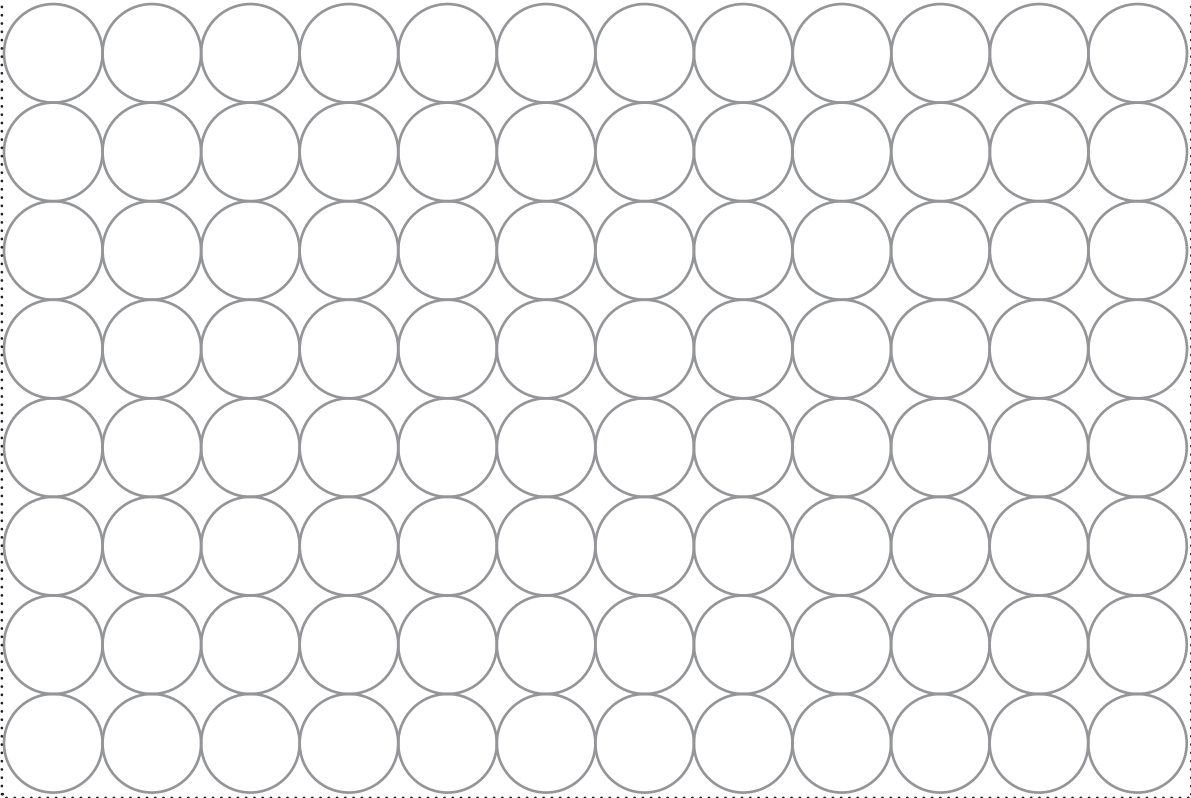

 - 2) Cut along the vertical and horizontal dotted lines and paste the pieces back together, matching up the letters and the dotted lines.
 - 3) Plan your design by filling in the circles with colored pencils or by placing the candies on the template before applying them to the cake; keep in mind that the ends should match up to create a seamless pattern.



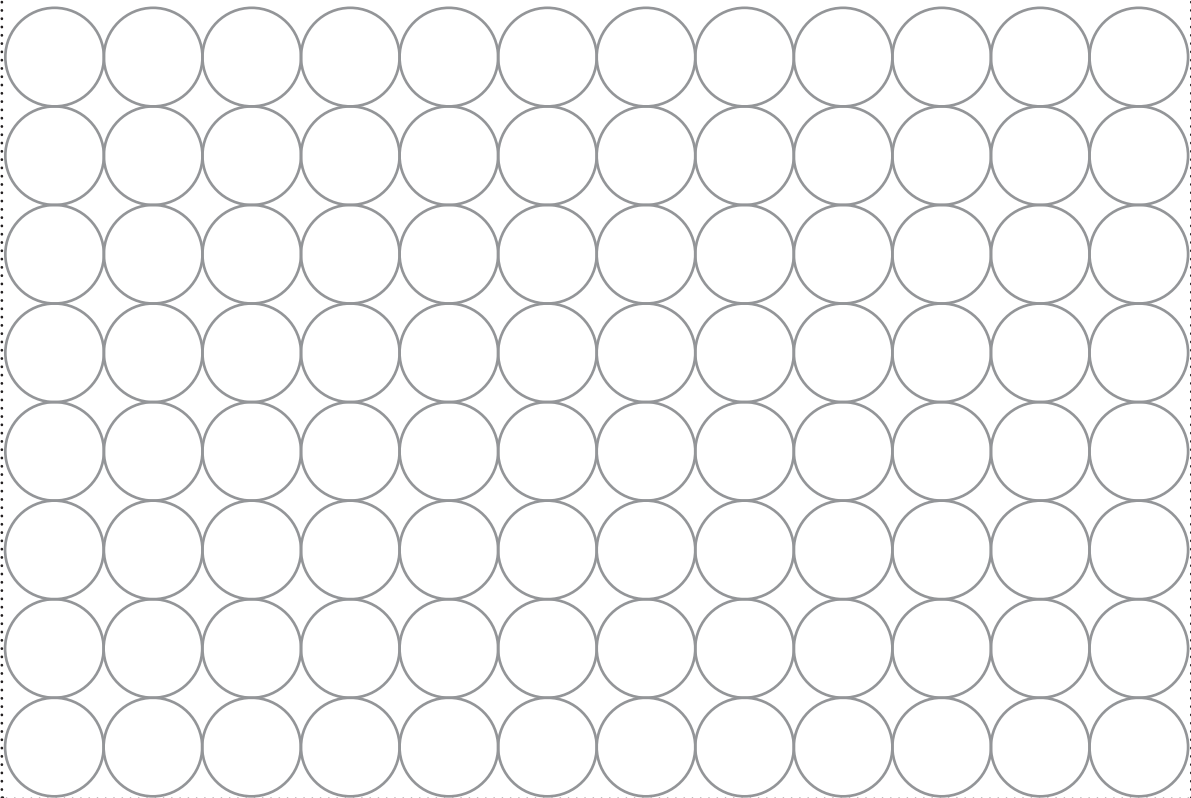

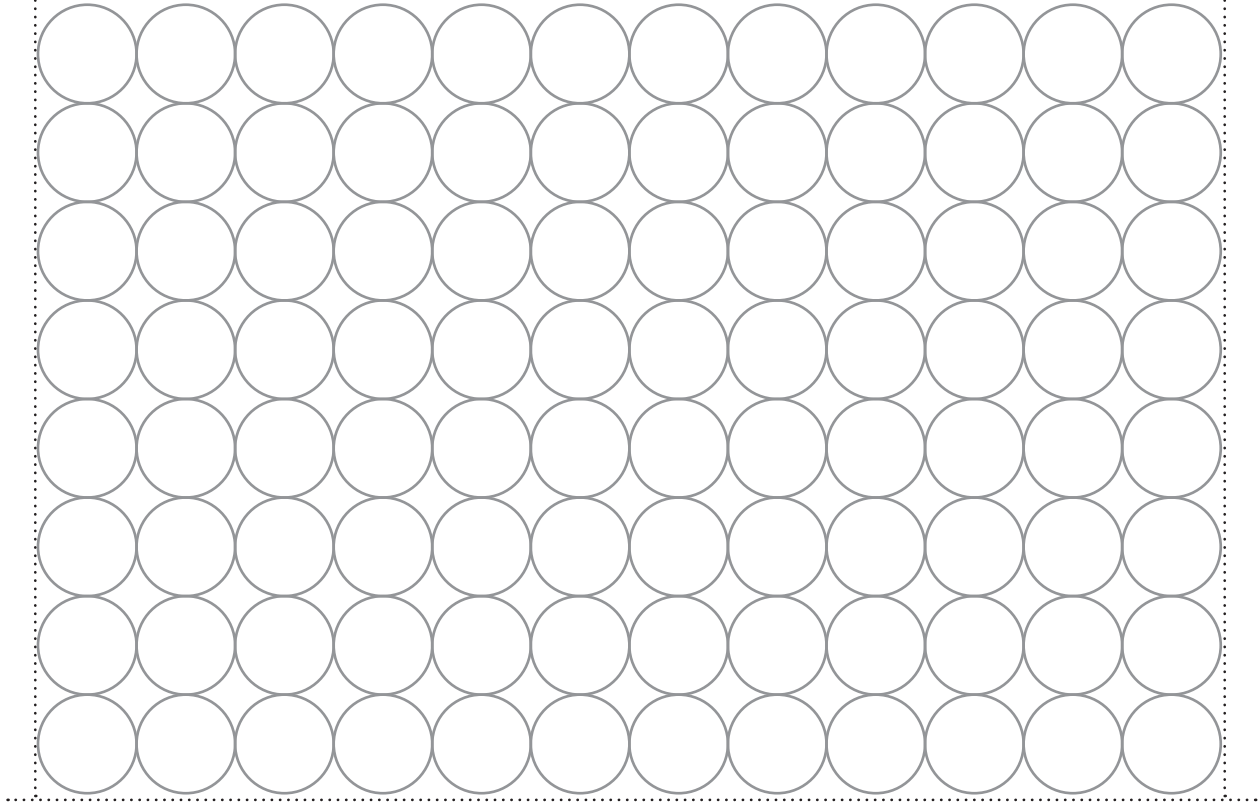
