Cut List for Making a Desk with a Storage Hutch

Acrylic tabletop: 1 @ 27 by 48 inches. Cut on your line, rather than beside it, to the outside for a slightly easier fit within the molding.

 $^{1}/_{2}$ -inch plywood cubby sides: 2 @ 7 $^{3}/_{4}$ by 12 inches

1/2-inch plywood cubby top and bottom: 2 @ 12 by 13 inches

1x3 apron: 1 @ 27 ½ inches

1x2 cleat: 1 @ 41 1/2 inches

1x2 cleat: 2 @ 20 1/2 inches

1x2 cleat: 1 @ 27 1/2 inches

1x2 cleat: 6 @ 6 1/2 inches

1x2 cleat: 2 @ 1 3/4 inches

1x2 strip: 1 @ 14 inches

Hutch shelves: 2 cut to size between the vertical dividers and

depth of the hutch

1/4x5 vertical dividers: 3 @ desired height; make them at least $4\frac{1}{4}$ inches tall to accommodate a standard envelope. Cut to the depth of the cabinet.

Hardboard: 1 cut to the height and width of the cabinet
